Federal Tax Credits for ENERGY STAR® Homes

- Single-Family New Homes \$2,500 available for ENERGY STAR certified homes.

 January 1, 2023 December 31, 2024 ENERGY STAR Single-Family New Home National Version 3.1 (or the regional program requirements applicable to the home).

 January 1, 2025 December 31, 2025 ENERGY STAR Single-Family New Homes National Version 3.2 (or the regional program requirements applicable
- Homes National Version 3.2 (or the regional program requirements upposed to the home).

 Manufactured Homes \$2,500 available for ENERGY STAR certified manufactured homes meeting the most recent ENERGY STAR Manufactured New Homes program requirements (currently Version 2, with Version 2-1 currently proposed to be implemented in May 2020).

 Multramity \$500 available for ENERGY STAR certified multifamily units meeting the ENERGY STAR Multifamily New Construction National program requirements for the regional program requirements applicable to the dwelling unit, as specified in Section 13304. A larger tax credit is available for multifamily projects that meet prevailing wage requirements.

A larger tax credit is available for homes that are certified to DOE's **Zero Energy Ready** (**ZERH) Program**, which requires ENERGY STAR certification as a prerequisite. All official information related to the tax certified will be determined and published by the IRS. The ENERGY STAR team is committed to keeping their partners informed as the IRS works to develop updated documents and guidance.
